Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the **Karnataka Educational Charitable Trust's Karnataka Ayurved college, KECT Tower, Near Daivagna Kalyana Mantapa Hoigebail, Ashoknagar Post, Moodbidri, Manglore Karnataka** with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 25 seats in 5 PG courses namely (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats, (ii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-05 seats, (iv) Panchakarma-05 seats and (v) Shalya Tantra-05 seats for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 – **reg.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. R.17011/81/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 08.08.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 02.02.2018 and re-visited on 23-24.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff, and Central Research Laboratory as per PG Ayurveda

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Regulation, 2016 were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 16.08.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, PG Ayurveda regulation, 2016 and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS) whereas, the aforesaid college is not fulfilling the approved criterion (PG Ayurveda Regulation 2016) for conducting PG course in (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats, (ii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-05 seats, (iv) Panchakarma-05 seats and (v) Shalya Tantra-05 seats.

4. It has been decided by the Central Government for **denial of permission to conduct PG course in** (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana-05 seats, (ii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-05 seats, (iv) Panchakarma-05 seats and (v) Shalya Tantra-05 seats **due to non-availability of Central Research Laboratory as per PG Ayurveda Regulation, 2016, and grant of conditional permission to the Karnataka Educational Charitable Trust's Karnataka Ayurved college, KECT Tower, Near Daivagna Kalyana Mantapa Hoigebail, Ashoknagar Post, Moodbidri, Manglore Karnataka with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 **subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018 :**

(i) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

(i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

(ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);

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- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto* and
- (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.

6. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
